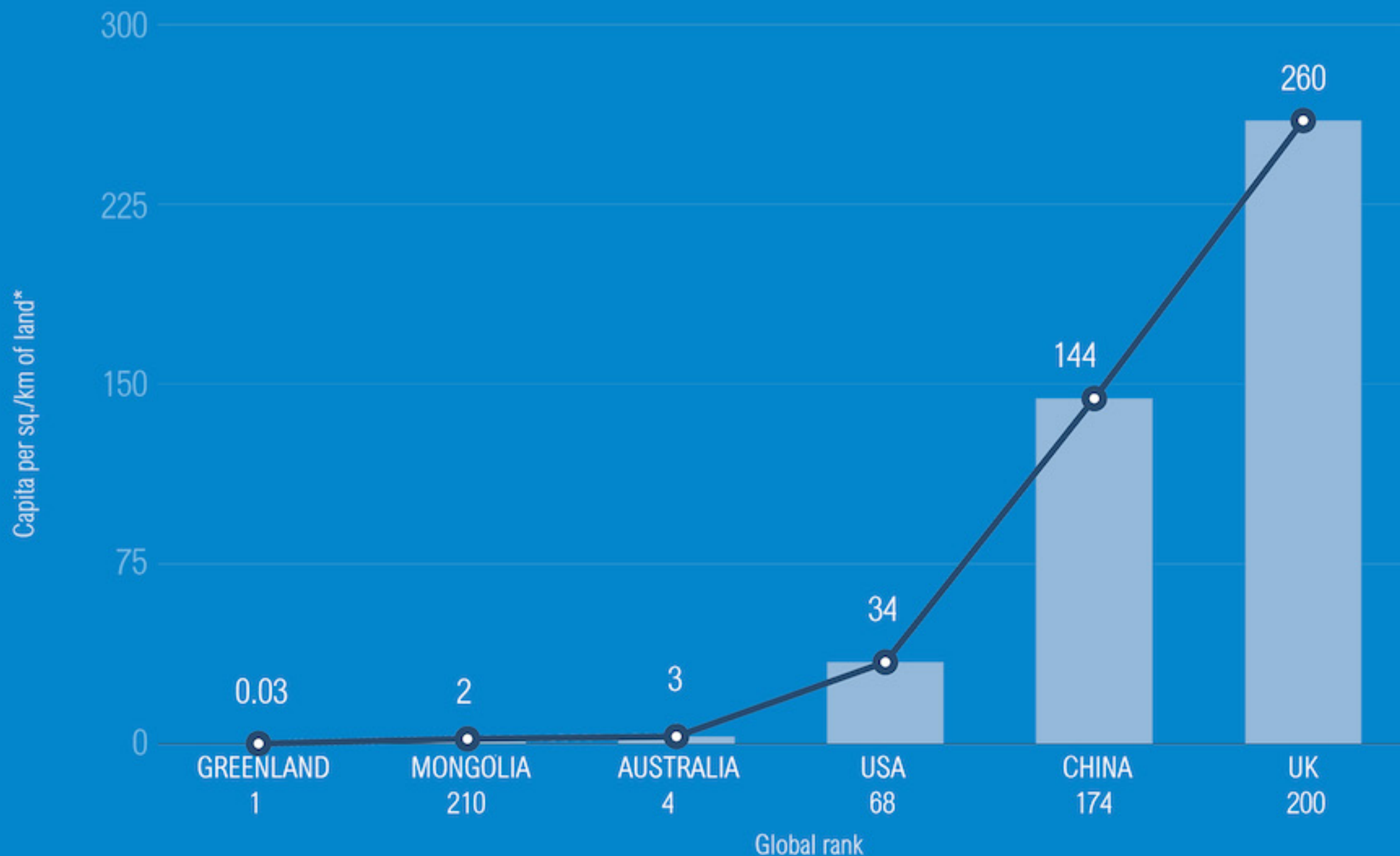

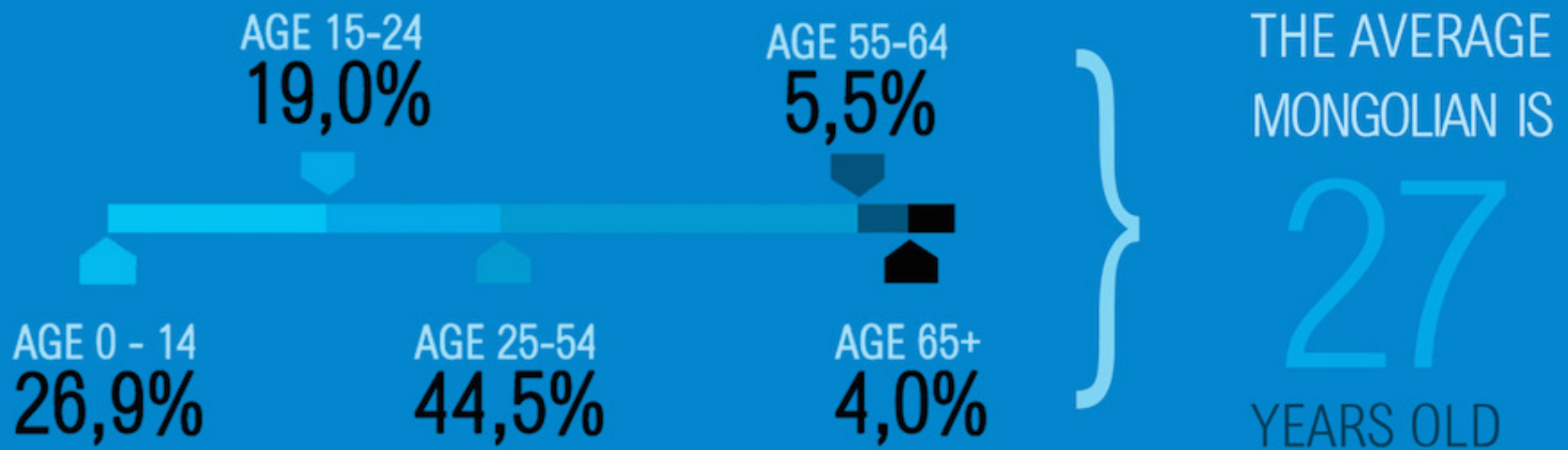

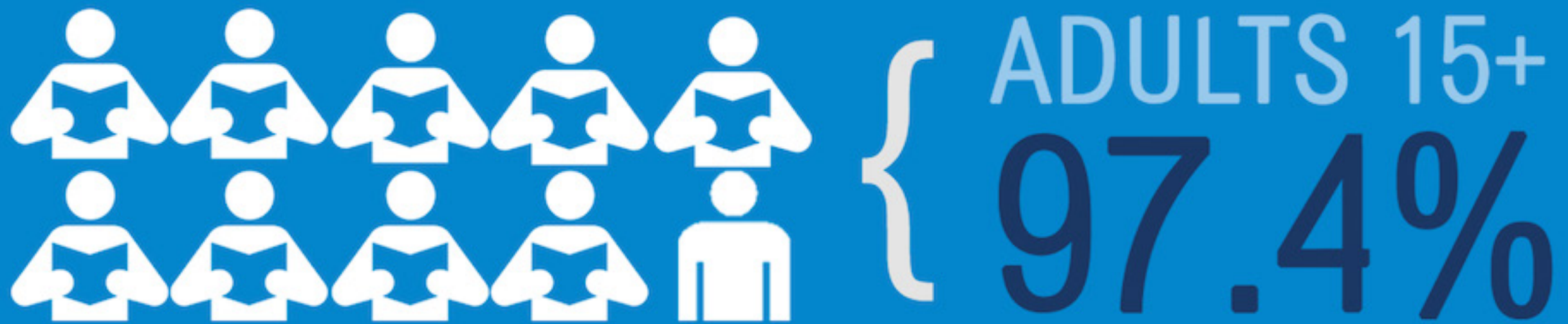

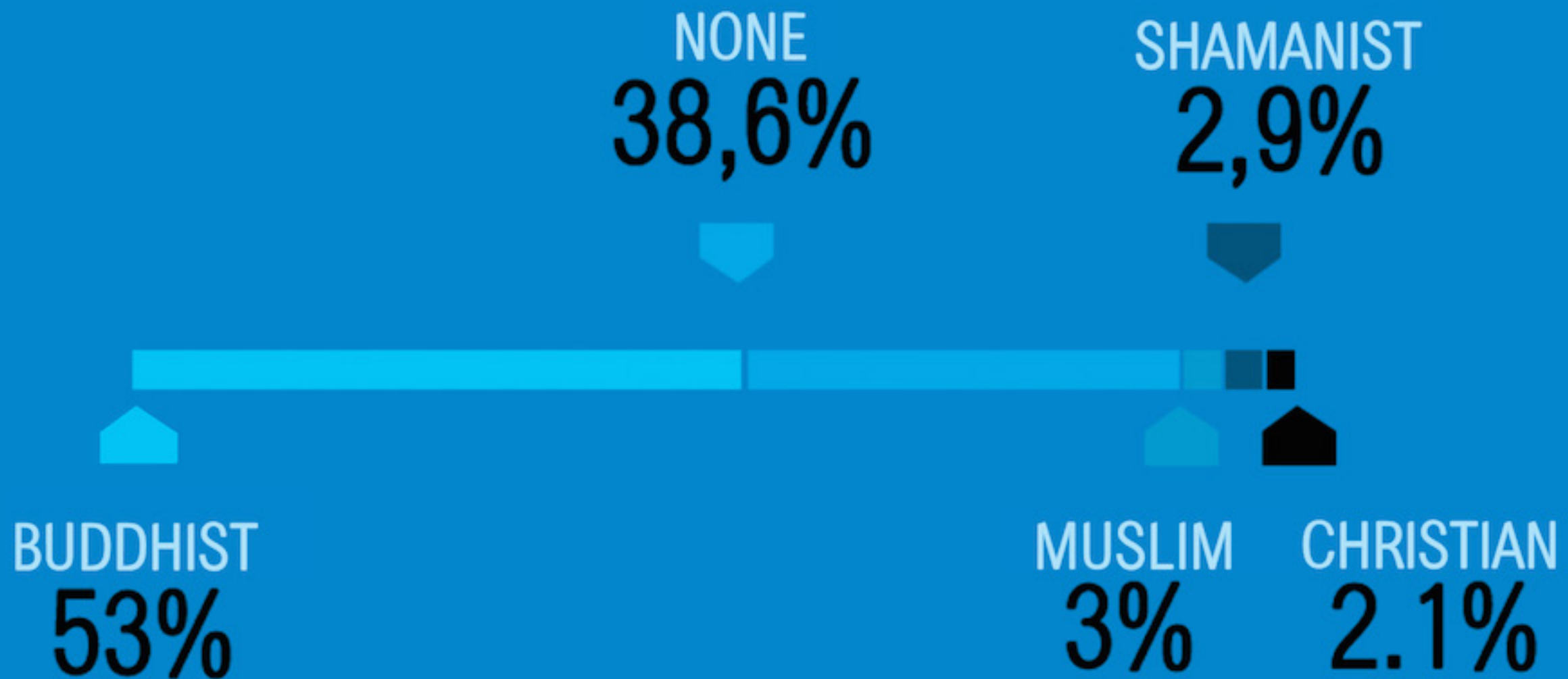

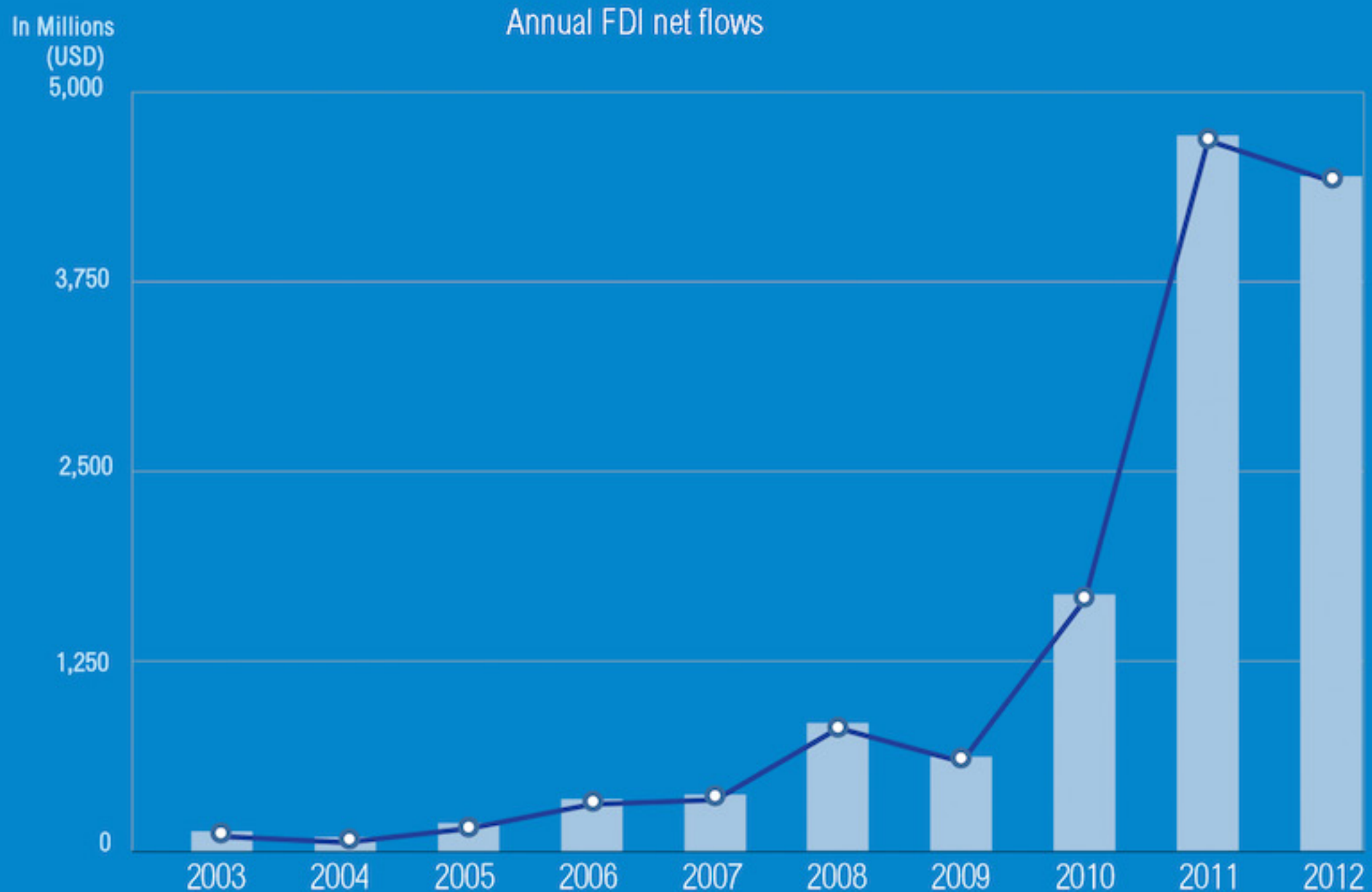

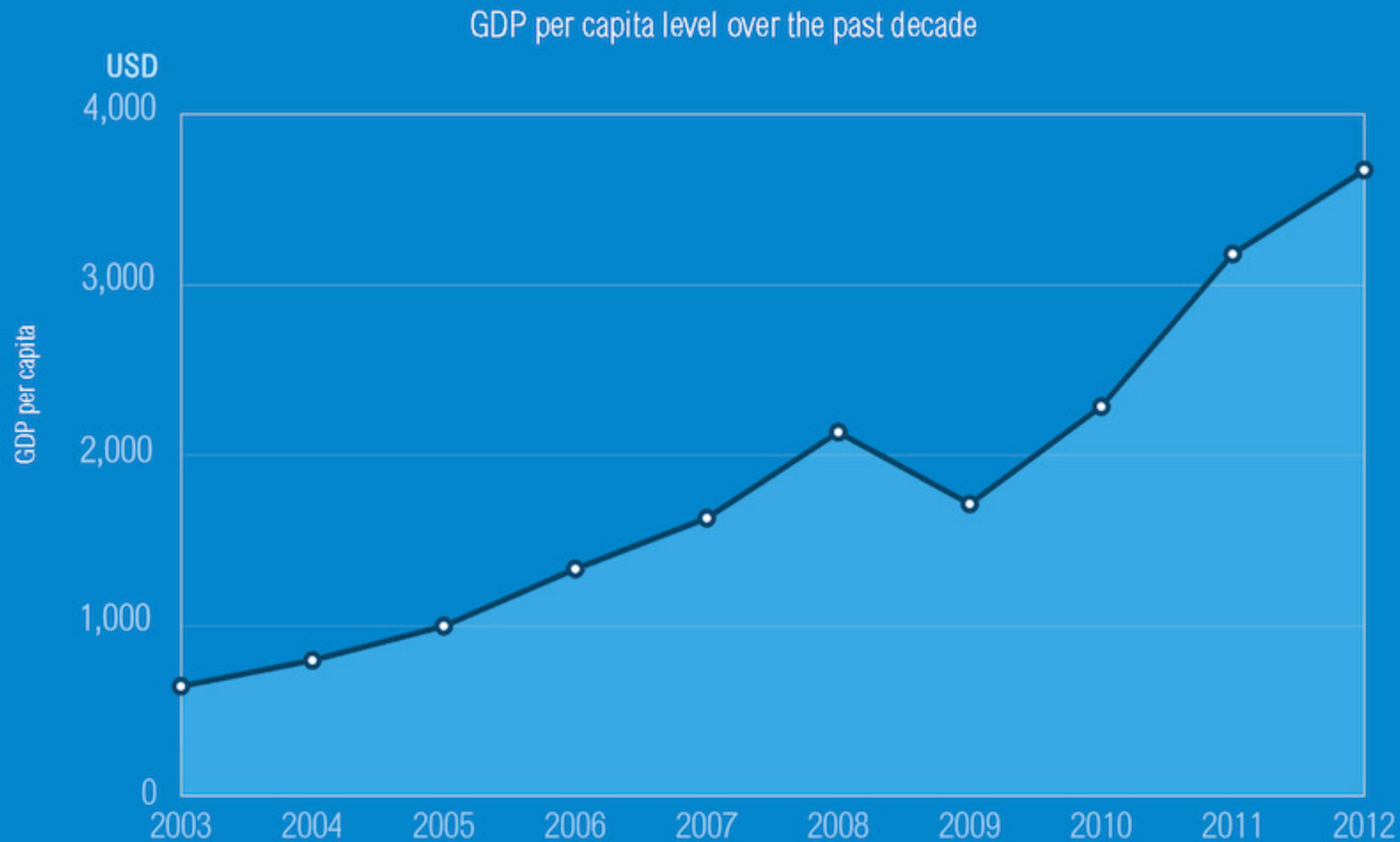




# Foreign Direct Investment has Increased Drastically in Recent Years

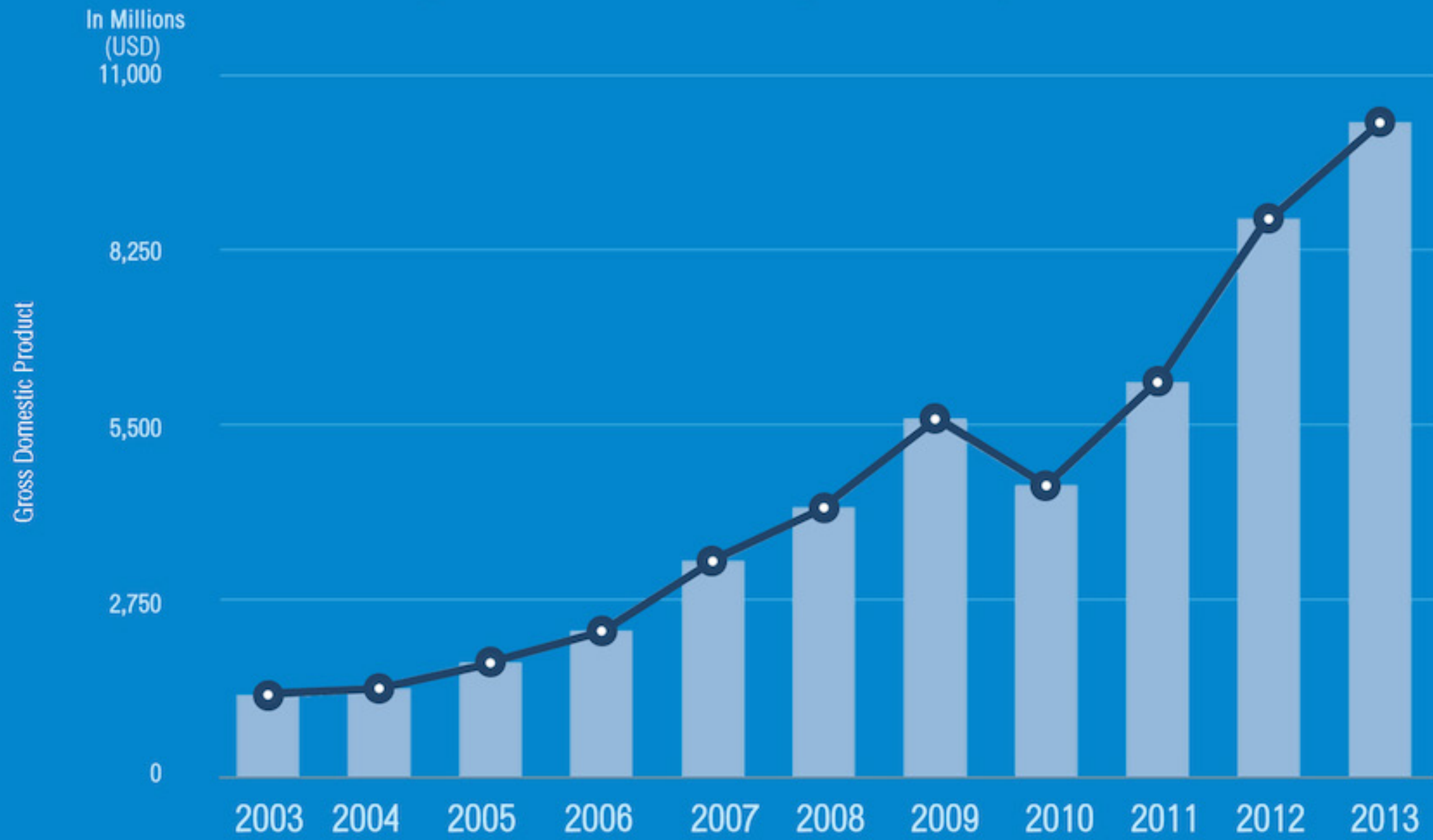


# With Small Population, impact on the GDP Per Capita is Direct
